



## Best Integrated Home

Level 5 (\$650,001-950,000)

### A Historic Home Gets Integrated

What happens when history meets technology? Creativity.

A real estate developer and builder of state-of-the-art malls worldwide, the owner of this gorgeous home and his wife are very active in local and national politics and community projects. In spite of their busy schedules, their family of three active teenagers is their top priority.

The family wanted a touchscreen-based system that would control security cameras, interior and exterior landscape lighting, and HVAC. The system would also control an 8-zone audio system, six plasma-based multimedia systems, and one media room. And if that's not enough, the homeowners also wanted to include telephone, Ethernet, and RF distribution.

The Fine Arts Commission that monitored the renovation of this historic mansion is adverse to technology, citing an interest in staying true to the historical integrity of architectural structures. Much of the home's interior space was "historically landmarked" and so many standard architectural fixtures weren't allowed. The plans called for two additional levels to be added under the house, including an indoor swimming pool.

Because of the restrictions imposed by the commission and the heavy infrastructure, the installation demanded unusual precision and creativity. The use of steel and concrete in this building required All Around Technology, the A/V installers retained by the homeowners, to work through every conceivable detail well in advance of construction.

For the lady of the home's "Command Center," she requested a touchscreen to automate house-wide control functions from a central location. The panel organizes control of all HVAC, audio, interior and exterior lighting, and security.

For the owner's office and library the AMX TPI touchscreen allowed AAT to simultaneously overlay all command-center functionality with security monitors, local television, and his computer desktop. The pop-up plasma can operate as a clone of the touchscreen or as a standalone television/computer monitor controlled by either a fixed or wireless touchscreen.

For the multiscreen media room a touchscreen interface makes this complicated setup easy to use. The built-in capability to host simultaneous X-box players keeps the kids and their large group of friends at home. *continued*

Staying true to the historical integrity of the home proved to be tricky, as the owners wanted to give it a complete audio-video makeover. All Around Technology exercised creativity to come up with a solution that would make both the Fine Arts commission and the owners happy.
